




The Trinity Reveals Perfect Agreement Without Sameness

True agreement does not erase our distinctions; it unites us around a shared submission to God. Biblical unity allows different roles, gifts, and expressions while keeping us aligned in purpose.

The Biblical Trinity

One God in Three Persons

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” (2 Corinthians 13:14)







Agreement Precedes Authority and Spiritual Power

Our spiritual authority flows from alignment with God, not from position, effort, or status. When we move in agreement with God's will, His power is released through our obedience.



JOHN 8:28-29

Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.

And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, left the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where for forty days he was tempted by the devil. He ate nothing during those days, and at the end of them he was hungry.

Humanity Was Created From Agreement and For Agreement

Genesis 2:18

ECCLESIASTES 4:9-12 “MADE FOR RELATIONSHIPS”

9 Two are better than one, Because they have a good reward for their labor. **10** For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up. **11** Again, if two lie down together, they will keep warm; But how can one be warm alone? **12** Though one may be overpowered by another, two can withstand him. And a threefold cord is not quickly broken.
