Part I - The Foundation of Agreement

What is AGREEMENT?

Biblically speaking, agreement is our alignment with God's nature, God's character, God's will, God's Word, and God's purposes, resulting in our thoughts, desires, decisions, and actions coming into harmony with Him.

Disagreement Begins When God's Word Is Questioned Rather Than Trusted

Agreement with God begins to fracture the moment His Word becomes something we edit instead of something we trust.


Genesis 3:1-3 *New American Standard Bible*

¹ Now the serpent was more cunning than any animal of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God really said, ‘You shall not eat from any tree of the garden’?” ² The woman said to the serpent, “From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat; ³ but from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God has said, ‘You shall not eat from it or touch it, or you will die.’”

and he will make your paths straight.



When God's goodness is doubted, obedience feels dangerous and independence starts to feel justified.


Genesis 3:4-5 *New American Standard Bible*

Disagreement Advances When Independence Replaces Submission to God's Authority

The moment we choose self-direction over submission, our alignment with God gives way to autonomy.



Disagreement Manifests in Broken Relationships Marked by Shame and Blame

When agreement with God is lost, we stop taking responsibility and start pointing fingers.

Genesis 3:7, 12-13 *New American Standard Bible*

⁷ Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves waist coverings.

¹² The man said, “The woman whom You gave *to be* with me, she gave me some of *the fruit of* the tree, and I ate.” ¹³ Then the LORD God said to the woman, “What is this *that* you have done?” And the woman said, “The serpent deceived me, and I ate.”


Part II - The Fracture of Agreement

Disagreement Distorts Identity and Fractures Our Sense of Purpose

When alignment with God is lost, we no longer know where we belong, who we are, or why we exist.

Genesis 3:1-13 *New American Standard Bible*


⁸ Now they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. ⁹ Then the LORD God called to the man, and said to him, “Where are you?” ¹⁰ He said, “I heard the sound of You in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid myself.”
