"A mustard seed of faith outweighs a mountain of fear, because its power is rooted in the faithfulness of God and not in us."





TEMPTATION OF JESUS IN MATTHEW 4:1-10






"Speaking God's Word releases our authority. When we declare His promises with faith, we are releasing heaven's authority into the earth."

Abiding in Christ empowers our authority, because staying connected to Him keeps the flow of His Spirit unhindered in us.






CAN TWO WALK

KEYS TO ACTIVATING OUR AUTHORITY - Key #5 — Boldness through the Spirit

Acts 4:29-31

²⁹ Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. ³⁰ Stretch out your hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus."

³¹ After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
